Frosty Paws Doggie Ice Cream

32 ounces vanilla yogurt, lowfat or fat free

2 tbsp honey

2 tbsp NATURAL peanut butter

1 large jar of banana baby food

Blend all ingredients together. Pour into small paper cups (or plastic cups to re-use) and freeze. Can be put in bowl or eaten straight out of the cup (if your pooch doesn't chew things)

Super Simple Chunky Peanut Butter Dog Treats

2 cups whole wheat flour

1 tbsp baking powder

1 cup chunky NATURAL peanut butter

1 cup nonfat milk.

Preheat oven to 375-degrees. Grease cookie sheets. In large bowl, combine flour and baking powder. Use another bowl and combine the peanut butter and milk. Add the milk and peanut butter mixture to the dry ingredients and mix well.

On floured surface, roll out to ¼" thick. Cut out using cookie cutters. Bake for about 20 minutes or until lightly browned. Allow treats to cool. Store in airtight containers.

In general, you should store dog treats the same way you would store homemade people cookies.
