The duo visited multiple veterinary specialists, and it was discovered that they both had eye deformities causing blindness. On top of their vision, Stevie was diagnosed with Bilateral Disease after showing signs incoordination and a mostly constant head tilt. Marvin received his own diagnosis of Hypersthesia which causes extreme senitivity on his back & by his tail. Because of this, Marvin will need to be on life long Gabapentin to help keep that sensitivity low. Their loving foster home has been with them from the begining and has worked so hard to socialize them and take them to every medical appointment over the last year. These charming boys will soon be looking for a home that enjoys double the fun, as they will need to remain a bonded pair. Thus far, their cost for care has been \$3.628.97

We test all cats for Feline Leukemia & FÍV. Unfortunately, Sunshine tested positive for Feline Leukemia (FELV). FELV can be contagious from one cat to another, and although there is a highly effective annual vaccine to prevent FELV, there is no cure, once infected. In some cases, cats with FELV can live a symptom free, healthy life, while others may develop a secondary infection that could impact their lifespan. Sunshine is currently symptom free, and has been living in a loving foster home where she enjoys playing with her favorite mouse toy. Sunshine's medical costs to date are \$352.69.
